The Medtronic Scholarship Program invests in high school students who are dedicated to leadership, service, and action that positively affects others. We are proud to offer financial assistance to employees' children as they pursue post-secondary education, such as college or vocational programs – supporting their desire to make a difference in the world.

Who is eligible?

To be eligible for a scholarship, students must be:

- The child of a Medtronic employee*
- Age 23 or younger
- A high school senior, high school graduate, or a current undergraduate
- Enrolled or planning to enroll in full-time (12+ credits) undergraduate courses at an accredited two- or four-year college, university, or vocational/ technical school
- * Medtronic employee must be active, U.S. or Puerto Rico-based, and scheduled to work 20+ hours per week. Children of Medtronic employees who are in a job level of Vice President or above are not eligible.

Scholarship amounts

Scholarship awards are valued between \$500 and \$1,500, and financial need of each recipient determines the specific amount of each award. The maximum amount of total awards per family is \$3,000 per year. Checks are mailed to each recipient's home address and are made payable to the school for the student.



Important dates

All required documents must be submitted to **Scholarship America by 3:00 p.m. CT on March 17, 2023**.

Students will be notified in **early June** if they have been selected to receive an award.

Awards will be paid **mid-August**.

How to apply

$Step 1 \cdots \Rightarrow Gather the following information:$

- A current, complete **transcript of grades** (high school or undergraduate). Transcripts must display the student's name, school, grades, and credit hours for each course and the term in which each course was taken. Grade reports are not accepted.
- **SAT or ACT scores** if a high school applicant and they are not listed on the high school transcript.
- One **letter of recommendation** submitted online on the student's behalf.
- The **Applicant Appraisal Form** found on learnmore.scholarsapply.org/medtronic.

Step 2 ···· > Complete application:

Visit <u>learnmore.scholarsapply.org/medtronic</u> to complete the online application process and upload the requested documents. You can save and return to your application as you complete the steps.

Step 3 ·····> Submit application:

Once you have reviewed your work and printed a copy of your application for your records, click Lock and Submit. After you submit, no changes can be made and you will no longer have access to your application account.

• All applications and submitted documentation are confidential and reviewed only by Scholarship America.

If your child has applied previously, they can reapply up to three additional years or until a bachelor's degree is earned.







How recipients are selected

Medtronic is committed to aiding as many students as we can. However, due to the large number of applications we receive, each year approximately 30% of the applicants receive scholarships.

Selection is based on:

- Academic record and honors
- Leadership and potential to succeed
- Participation in school and community activities
- Work experience
- Educational and career goals
- Letter of recommendation

Recipient selection and awards are granted by Scholarship America, without regard to race, color, creed, religion, sexual orientation, gender, disability, or national origin. Once recipients are selected, financial need is assessed to determine the award amount. If no financial information is submitted in the Financial Data section of the application, the student will receive the minimum award amount.

Medtronic will receive names of the recipients which may be announced in internal Medtronic publications.

Recipient responsibilities

If a scholarship is awarded, your child must enter school no later than the upcoming fall term. If they do not attend school on a full-time basis for the entire academic year, a portion of the total award will be adjusted.

Recipients are required to notify Scholarship America of any changes to school enrollment or other relevant information.
