



CentroMotion Dependent Scholarship Program

THE PROGRAM

CentroMotion has established a scholarship program to assist children of employees who plan to continue their education in college or vocational school programs.

This program is administered by Scholarship America®, the nation's largest designer and manager of scholarship, tuition assistance and other education support programs for corporations, foundations, associations, and individuals. Awards are granted without regard to race, color, creed, religion, sexual orientation, gender, disability, or national origin.

Applicants are responsible for gathering and submitting all necessary information. Applications are evaluated on the information supplied; therefore, answer all questions as completely as possible. Incomplete applications will not be evaluated. All information received is considered confidential and is reviewed only by Scholarship America.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants to the CentroMotion Dependent Scholarship Program must be:

- Dependent* children, age 24 and under, of full-time CentroMotion employees who have a minimum of one year of employment as of the application deadline.

**Dependent children are defined as biological, step- or legally adopted children living in the employee's household or primarily supported by the employee.*

- High school seniors or graduates, or current postsecondary undergraduates, who plan to enroll in full-time undergraduate study at an accredited two-year or four-year college, university, or vocational-technical school for the entire upcoming academic year.

AWARDS

If selected as a recipient, the student will receive a \$500 award.

Awards may be renewed for up to three additional years or until a bachelor's degree is earned, whichever occurs first. Renewal is contingent upon satisfactory academic performance in a full-time course of study, continued employment of the student's parent at CentroMotion, and continuation of the program by CentroMotion.

As part of your application, you must upload the following:

A current, complete transcript of grades. Grade reports are not accepted. Transcripts must display student name, school name, grades and credit hours for each course and term in which each course was taken.

Your application is **not** complete unless all required materials are submitted electronically.



SELECTION OF RECIPIENTS

Scholarship recipients are selected on the basis of academic record, demonstrated leadership and participation in school and community activities, work experience, a statement of goals and aspirations, and unusual personal or family circumstances.

Selection of recipients is made by Scholarship America. In no instance does any officer or employee of CentroMotion play a part in the selection. All applicants agree to accept the decision as final.

PAYMENT OF SCHOLARSHIPS

Scholarship America processes scholarship payments on behalf of CentroMotion. Payments are made in one installment in early August in the U.S. Awards are sent to the student by wire transfer outside the U.S.

OBLIGATIONS

Recipients have no obligation to CentroMotion. They are, however, required to notify Scholarship America of any changes in address, school enrollment, or other relevant information and to send a complete transcript when requested.

REVISIONS

CentroMotion reserves the right to review the conditions and procedures of this scholarship program and to make changes at any time including termination of the program.
