





- You can upload up to 10 transcripts, only 1 is required to submit.
- Upload a current transcript which should include:
 - It can be unofficial or official, both are accepted
 - Your name
 - The school's name
 - A full list of completed grades with credit hours and terms in which the course was taken
 - Cumulative GPA
- **DO NOT** upload a grad report or school schedule. These will not be accepted.
- Which type of transcript you should upload
 - If you are a high school senior or graduate who has not yet taken college courses: upload a high school transcript
 - If you are an undergraduate student: upload your most up to date college transcript
- If you have attended multiple schools, please upload all transcripts
 - As part of your submission, you must upload the following document(s):
 - A current, complete transcript of grades, including the most recently completed term. Transcripts must display student name, school name, grade and credit hours, and term in which the course was taken.







COMMONLY ASKED QUESTIONS/ FAQ

- **Do I need to complete the entire application in one session?**
 - No you can save and return to your application at any time until the deadline date.
 - To access your application, log in with your Hub account information. Click on Dashboard at the top and your application will be there. You can continue at whichever section you have left to complete.
- **Can I apply if I am planning to attend graduate school?**
 - No, the scholarship is only open to those who are enrolled in an undergraduate course of study.
- **Can my transcript be unofficial?**
 - Yes, you do not need to submit an unofficial transcript. But it should include, your name, the school's name and a full list of completed courses with credit hours and GPA.
 - If you have attended multiple schools, please attach all transcripts
- **Can I make changes to my application once it has been submitted?**
 - No, once your application has been submitted, it is final. If you need to make changes, please contact Scholarship America at panda@scholarshipamerica.org

- **What can the scholarship be used towards?**
 - The award can be used towards education related expenses such as tuition, fees, book and supplies. Any further questions would need to be addressed with your school.
- **What is the amount of the scholarship?**
 - The amount of the scholarship will depend on both your full-time or part-time enrollment and will not exceed 80% of your tuition fees. The maximum amount you can receive as a part-time student is \$1,200. The maximum amount you can receive as a full-time student is \$2,500. Award amounts will be adjusted accordingly to your enrollment and school choice.
- **Is the award renewable?**
 - Yes the scholarship is renewal, up to 5 years or until a Bachelor's degree has been earned, whichever occurs first.
 - You must continue to meet eligibility requirements
 - Maintaining a 2.7 cumulative GPA or higher on a 4.0 scale
 - Enroll in part-time for full-time undergraduate course of study
 - Continue to be employed by Panda Restaurant Group in a position of Shift Leader, Training Leader, General Manager, Assistance Manager, Chef, Cook, Counter Help or Kitchen Help or Support Center Associate (permanent status an up to P3 level)
 - In good standing or have been promoted to a high position approved by Panda
 - Continue to work an average of 30 hours/week
- **When will I find out if I have been selected for an award or that my award has been renewed?**
 - All applicants and renewal students will be notified in early December regarding their status.
- **When will checks be disbursed?**
 - Checks will be disbursed in on installment in December. You must remain employed at the time of check payments to receive your scholarship. If your employment with Panda has ended, you will forfeit your remaining award and not receive a check.
- **How will checks be disbursed?**
 - Checks are made payable to the institution where the student is enrolled. A paper check will be mailed to the student's home address that is on file.
- **My school choice has changed, what do I need to do?**
 - Please email Scholarship America at panda@scholarshipamerica.org to have your school choice updated
- **My address has changed, what do I need to do?**
 - Please email Scholarship America at panda@scholarshipamerica.org to have your address updated
- **If I need a new check due to a school or address change, it has been lost or is now stale, what should I do?**
 - Email panda@scholarshipamerica.org explaining the situation and a new check will be sent.
