  - Graduating high school senior and a resident from Bexar county
  - Attend a U.S. college or university
  - Full-time enrollment for the entire upcoming academic year
  - Demonstrated financial need
- ***James H. and Ann P. Bissett Scholarship***
  - Graduating high school senior from Bexar county
  - Study for a career in nursing or medical technology
  - Attend a college or university in Bexar county (must be first college choice)
  - Full-time enrollment for the entire upcoming academic year
- ***Anna, Pierre, and Ephraim Block Scholarship***
  - Graduating high school senior from any high school located in Dimmit, Duval, Hidalgo, Jim Hogg, La Salle, Starr, Webb or Zapata county
  - A Texas resident
  - Involvement in extra-curricular activities within their high school or community
  - Special consideration for students attending a college or university in the State of Texas (must be first college choice)
  - Full-time enrollment for the entire upcoming academic year
  - Demonstrated financial need
- ***Carvajal Educational Scholarship***
  - Graduating high school senior from Atascosa, Bandera, Bexar, Comal, Guadalupe, Kendall, Medina, or Wilson
  - Minimum 3.00 GPA
  - Student must provide a recommendation letter from a pastor, church minister or teacher
  - Attend a Judeo Christian affiliated institution in the U.S. (must be first college choice)
  - Full-time enrollment for the entire upcoming academic year
- ***Emo Jean Cottrell***
  - Graduating high school senior from Bexar county
  - Participation in extracurricular activities and/or community service
  - Full-time enrollment for the entire upcoming academic year at a U.S. college or university
- ***Franque and Philip Curtis Scholarship***
  - Graduating high school senior from Bexar or Kendall county
  - Attend a U.S. college, university, or vocational school
  - Full-time enrollment for the entire upcoming academic year
  - Demonstrated financial need
- ***Florence Emma Eichler Scholarship***
  - Graduating high school senior from Bexar, Atascosa, Bandera, Comal, Guadalupe, Kendall, Medina or Wilson county
  - Minimum 2.0 GPA
  - Full-time enrollment for the entire upcoming academic year
  - Attend a U.S. college or university

- **Joseph, Rose, Myron, and Norman Fink Memorial Scholarship**
  - Graduating high school senior from San Antonio
  - Attend a U.S. college, university, or vocational school
  - Full-time enrollment for the entire upcoming academic year
  - Demonstrated financial need
- **Walter E. and Evelyn H. Haggard Scholarship**
  - Graduating high school senior from Bexar county
  - Resident of Bexar county
  - Pursue a degree in engineering
  - Attend a college or university in Texas (must be first college choice)
  - Full-time enrollment for the entire upcoming academic year
  - Demonstrated financial need
- **Frank H. and Zona T. Hall Scholarship**
  - Graduating high school senior from Bexar county
  - Attend a U.S. college, university, or vocational school
  - Full-time enrollment for the entire upcoming academic year
  - Demonstrated financial need
- **Patricia L. Hartman and Lois C. Hartman Scholarship Fund**
  - Graduate from a high school in Bexar county
  - Special consideration given to graduates from Alamo Heights High School
  - Full-time enrollment for the entire upcoming academic year at a U.S. college or university
  - This is a nonrenewable fund. However students may receive this award an additional three years if they reapply and fulfil eligibility requirements
- **Carol Lee Jones Educational and Cultural Fund**
  - Minimum 2.5 GPA
  - Graduating high school senior or former graduate of GW Brackenridge High School
  - Must attend a four-year undergraduate program at a U.S. accredited college or university
  - Full-time enrollment for the entire upcoming academic year
- **Hedwig T. Kniker Scholarship**
  - Graduating high school senior from Bexar county and resident of the city of San Antonio
  - Must be single
  - Majoring in Chemistry, Botany, Geology, Physics, Zoology or the Arts (Internal note: any liberal arts major qualifies)
  - Attend a college or university in San Antonio (must be first college choice)
  - Full-time enrollment for the entire upcoming academic year
  - Demonstrated financial need
- **Alfred W. Negley Scholarship**
  - Graduating high school senior from Bexar county
  - Student must be under 30 years old
  - Major in accounting, business/business management, or transportation
  - Preference given to students attending the University of Texas at San Antonio (must be first college choice)
  - Attend a college or university in Bexar county (must be first college choice)
  - Full-time or part-time enrollment for the entire upcoming academic year
  - Demonstrated financial need
- **Sally P. and Glenn L. Ramsdell Scholarship Fund**
  - Graduating high school senior from Bexar county
  - Preference given to students majoring in accounting and business administration
  - Attend a U.S. college, university, or vocational school
  - Full-time enrollment for the entire upcoming academic year

- ***Rapier Educational Foundation***
  - Student who lives in a county served by WellMed Medical Management\*
  - Minimum 2.5 GPA
  - Attend an accredited 2 or 4 year institution or vocational/technical school in the U.S.
  - Scholarship is for undergraduate study only
  - Full-time enrollment for the entire upcoming academic year
  - Financial need considered, but not a determining factor
- ***Theodore and Rita Rittiman Texas A&M Scholarship***
  - Graduating high school senior from Judson ISD in Converse
  - Minimum 3.0 GPA
  - Full-time enrollment in the College of Engineering at Texas A&M University (must be first college choice)
  - Full-time enrollment for the entire upcoming academic year
- ***John L. Santikos Companies Employee Scholarship Fund***
  - Be an employee or the employee's immediate family member (defined as spouse, child(ren), stepchildren, grandchildren, step-grandchildren, or other dependents living in the employee's home and for which the employee is financially responsible).
  - Student must have worked at least 500 hours during the 12-months prior to the application
  - Have a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA on a 4.0 scale
  - Be enrolled or planning to enroll at an accredited two- or four-year college or university or vocational/technical school for at least 6 undergraduate credits or 3 graduate credits
  - This is a nonrenewable fund. However, students may receive this award an additional three years if they reapply and fulfil eligibility requirements.
- ***Walter and Hannelore Schwindt Scholarship***
  - Graduating high school senior from the following counties: Gillespie, Kendall, Comal, Mason, Blanc, Llano, Kerr or Bexar
  - Minimum 95/100 GPA or a 4.0 GPA
  - Major in physics, math, astronomy, medical research, chemistry, biochemistry (and other scientific and/or technical fields), linguistics, music or agricultural research
  - Full-time enrollment for the entire upcoming academic year at a U.S. college or university
  - Student can pursue post-graduate education
- ***Loretta B. Simpson Scholarship Fund***
  - Graduating high school senior from San Antonio
  - Involvement in extracurricular activities or community service
  - Attend a U.S. college, university, or vocational school
  - Full-time enrollment for the entire upcoming academic year
- ***Harvey P. Smith, Jr. and Rebecca Smith Patton Memorial Scholarship***
  - Graduating high school senior from Bexar county
  - U.S. citizen
  - Studying archeology
  - Attend a U.S. college, university, or vocational school
  - Full-time enrollment for the entire upcoming academic year
  - Demonstrated financial need

- **Robert B. Taylor Fund**
  - Graduate of a high school from Bexar or surrounding counties (Medina, Atascosa, Wilson, Guadalupe, Comal, Kendall, Bandera, Gillespie, Blanco, Gonzales, Karnes, Frio and Kerr)
  - Must be Black/African American
  - Preference given to students attending one of the Alamo Community Colleges: Northeast Lakeview College, Northwest Vista College, Palo Alto College, St. Phillip's College or San Antonio College
  - Must study in a vocational field such as automotive, hospitality or culinary arts or in the field of medicine such as nursing, pre-med or physician assistance
  - Full-time enrollment for the entire upcoming academic year
  - Demonstrate financial need
- **Charlotte and Jule S. Theobald Scholarship Trust**
  - Veterinary major
  - Must be enrolled in the School of Veterinary Medicine at Texas A&M-College Station, (must be first college choice)
  - Full-time enrollment for the entire upcoming academic year
- **J. Kent Trinkle Scholarship**
  - Graduating high school senior from a school in Bexar county
  - Attend a U.S. college or university
  - Full-time or part-time enrollment
  - Demonstrated financial need
- **Olga Seiser Vincent Music Scholarship**
  - Female graduating high school senior from Bexar county
  - Major in music (preferably piano)
  - Attend a college or university in Bexar county (must be first college choice)
  - Full-time enrollment for the entire upcoming academic year
  - Demonstrated financial need
- **R. L. White Scholarship**
  - Graduating high school senior from Bexar, Brown, Uvalde, Taylor or Parker county
  - Enrolled at UTSA College of Engineering (must be first college choice)
  - Full-time enrollment for the entire upcoming academic year
- **Della Mabel Wright Scholarship Trust**
  - Resident of Stoddard or Bollinger county in Missouri
  - Attend either Southeast Missouri State University or the University of Missouri (must be first college choice)
  - Full-time enrollment for the entire upcoming academic year
  - Recipient has demonstrated qualities of leadership, integrity, good character and industriousness (Internal note: see activities for leadership roles and essay for evidence of these qualities)
  - Demonstrated financial need
- **Ernest B and Marie H. Graham Scholarship Fund**
  - Graduating high school senior from SAISD, NEISD, and Northside ISD
  - Planning to major in Math (Internal note: accounting, finance, economics, etc. are not eligible majors for new recipients)
- **Jean Y. and Robert W. Fish Memorial Scholarship Fund**
  - Graduating high school senior from Bexar county
  - US Citizen
  - Demonstrate outstanding citizenship traits
  - Demonstrated financial need
  - Full-time enrollment for the entire upcoming academic year
- **Penny Ann Powers Scholarship**
  - Attend community college
  - Preference for single mothers at least 40 years old
  - Part-time students eligible

- **Erin Wilson McMahon Memorial Scholarship Fund**
  - Have graduated from a high school in Bexar county (current high school seniors must have a minimum 3.0 GPA and current college students must have a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA);
  - Have academic achievement and have participated or been in a leadership role in an extracurricular activity such as, but not limited to, band, Latin Club, theater, or choir; or in any outside organization such as, but not limited to, a church and/or mission group or animal rescue group; and
  - Are pursuing a four-year undergraduate program at an accredited college, university or nonprofit vocational/technical school outside of Texas and in the U.S.
  - Student must have a personal or family connection to the student's college/region
  - Financial need will be considered but will not be the sole determining factor.
- **Kym's Kids Scholarship**
  - Have a permanent address in Bexar county
  - Have a minimum 2.5 GPA or above;
  - Are enrolled at a 2- or 4-year college, university or vocational school;
  - Would be unable to attend college without financial assistance;
  - Have worked or volunteered in the community.
  - Preference will be given to students who participated in the post-graduate Kym's Kids program
- **Ajay Castro Scholarship**
  - Be female and an undergraduate student majoring in a Communications-related field, including print or broadcast journalism, public relations, advertising, speech communication such as public speaking, digital media, etc.
  - Preference will be given to a re-entering student, defined as an individual enrolled in a college or university after a minimum three-year lapse from graduating high school or leaving the academic world.
  - Be a high school graduate or have earned a GED
  - Have a minimum 2.0 GPA in all college work after lapse
  - Plan to enroll at a Bexar county university or college
