

San Antonio Area Foundation Scholarship Program – Common Application Instructions

Steps to fully complete an application:

1. Access the landing page, review the program eligibility and click 'Apply Now'
2. Create your account or log into your previous account
3. Update your profile and save
4. Click 'Scholarships' and locate the San Antonio Area Foundation Scholarship Programs – Common Application
5. Complete your application, making sure all questions with an asterisks are completed
6. Upload transcript
7. Lock and Submit

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Application Documents Review

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- **Documents Section**

- You can upload up to 10 transcripts, only 1 is required to submit.
- Upload a current transcript which should include:
 - It can be unofficial or official, both are accepted
 - Your name
 - The school's name
 - A full list of completed grades with credit hours and terms in which the course was taken
 - Cumulative GPA
- **DO NOT** upload a grad report or school schedule. These will not be accepted.
- Which type of transcript you should upload
 - If you are a high school senior or graduate who has not yet taken college courses: upload a high school transcript
 - If you are an undergraduate student: upload your must up to date college transcript
- If you have attended multiple schools, please upload all transcripts

As part of your submission, you must upload the following document(s):

- A current, complete transcript of grades, including the most recently completed term. Transcripts must display student name, school name, grade and credit hours, and term in which the course was taken.


